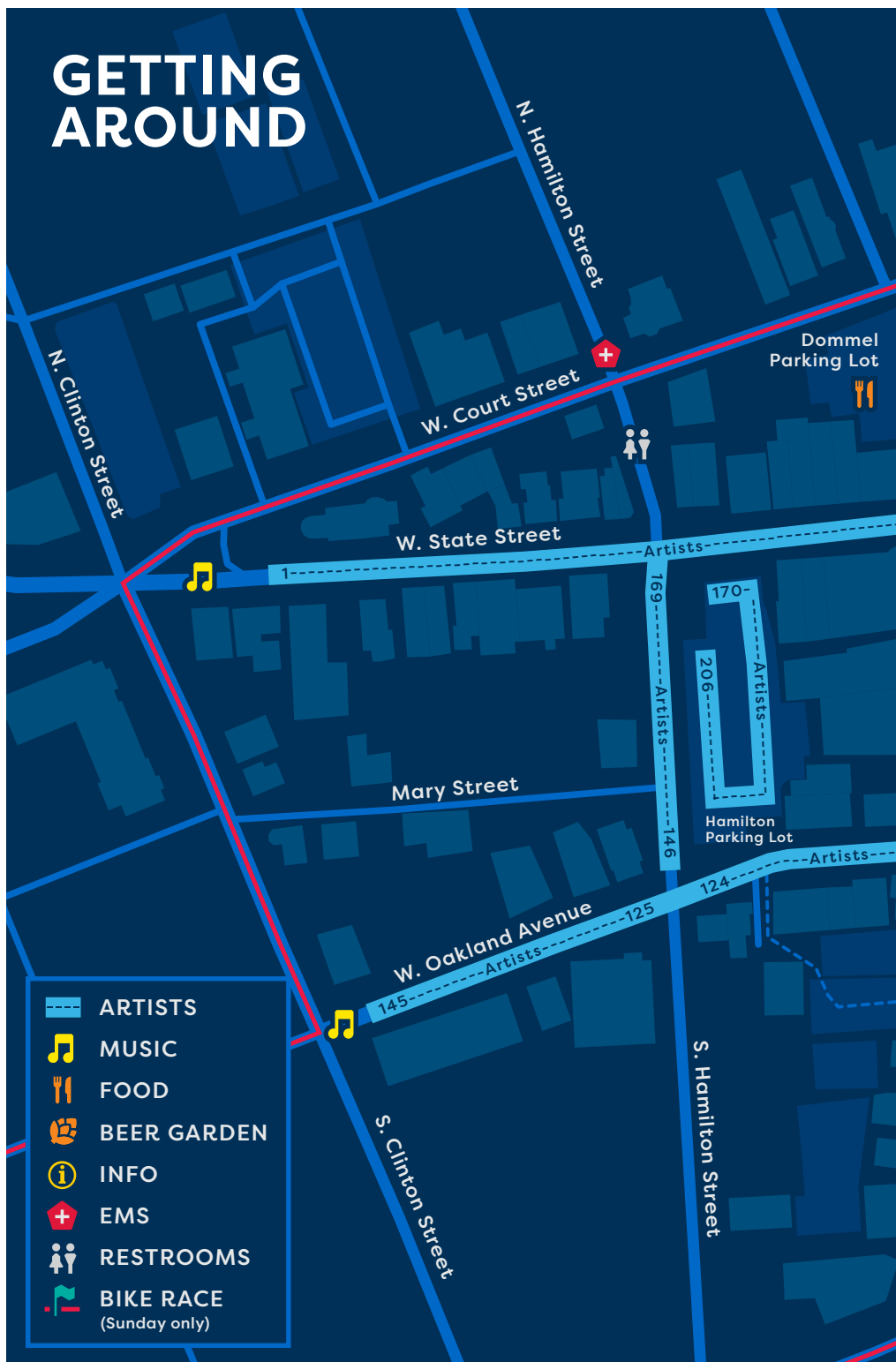

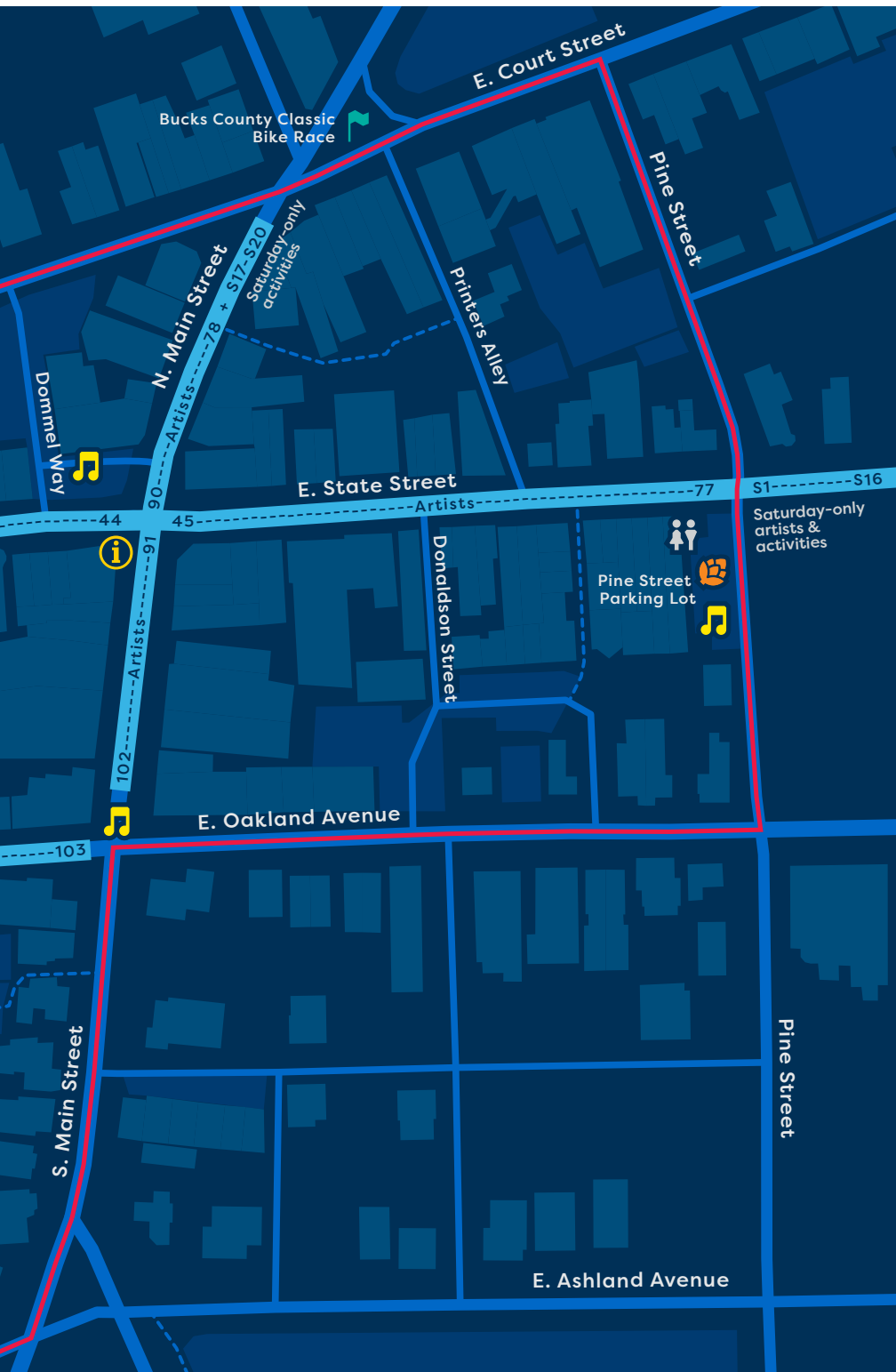

LOOKING AHEAD TO 2026

Looking for ways to get involved in the Doylestown Arts Festival? Due to high demand, each year we put out calls for involvement in early January.
